

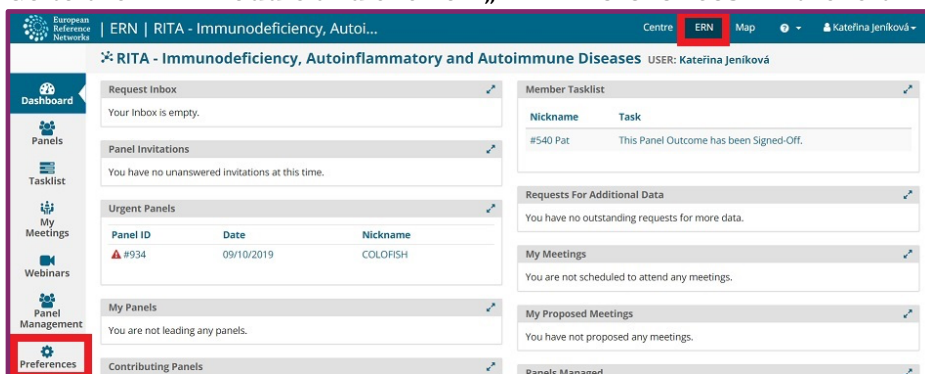
EXPERTISE DESCRIPTION – My professional role (MPR)

What you put in the MPR box is the first and only thing that is visible next to your name in the list of RITA experts.

It means this description will identify your role in CPMS (**component A**) and your expertise & subspecialty (**component B**) to other experts that don't know you and could use your help in their panels.

Where to change it:

1. Log in to CPMS. <https://cpms.ern-net.eu/login/>
2. Go to the **ERN** module and click on „**ERN Preferences**“ in the left menu bar.

What to do:

- 1) **Select all thematic areas** of your expertise. **Selected areas must match your real expertise** also correspond to the streams your HCP was approved for.
- 2) Then fill the “**My professional role**” box with A, B components. **There is no dropdown menu, you have to fill it manually.**

For component A you choose from:

- “**Consultant**” refers to the highest expertise level allowing for panel consultations, not to the official post within your center or unit.
- “**Fellow**” refers to trainees and junior faculty members involved in patient data completion and/or panel progress and communication.
- “**Guest consultant**” is a treating physician from a non-ERN institution invited by the RITA coordinator or stream lead to join RITA CPMS, usually because of a very specific expertise.

- **“Guest referring physician”** is a treating physician from a non-ERN institution invited by the RITA coordinator or stream lead to join RITA CPMS for enrolling a patient into the CPMS.
- **“Administrator”** is a person who provides technical/administrative help to the CPMS panel flow.

In component B you describe whether you specialize on **ped/adult** care, specify your **specialty, subspecialty**, or anything relevant to your expertise assessment.

Here are some examples:

- MPR box of prof. Pavla Dolezalova: *consultant, paediatric rheumatology, paediatric vasculitis*
- MPR box of junior Sarka Fingerhutova: *fellow, paediatrician, paediatric rheumatology*
- MPR box of a PhD student or alike (in the training process): *fellow, paediatrics trainee*
